The museum is located at 2727 Pokegama Ave. in Grand Rapids.

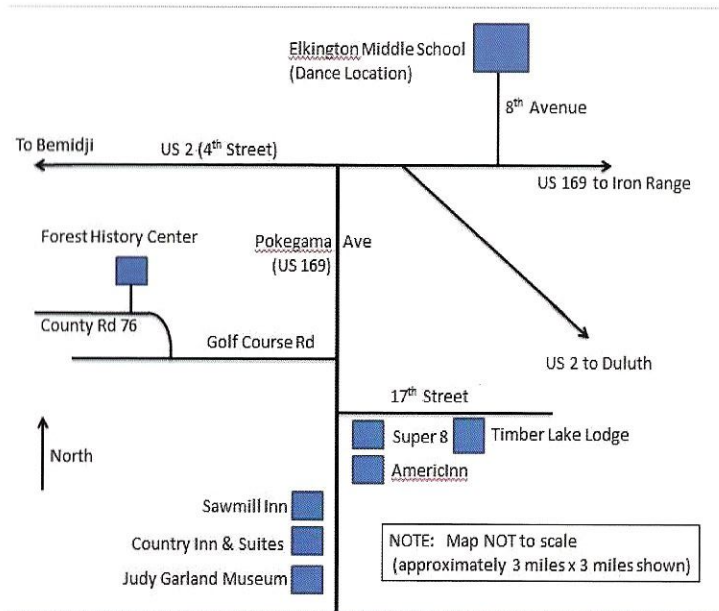
**There will be a contest at our convention for those interested in dressing in costume on Saturday. The best costume will win one free hotel night. More details to come
